Proposal	Changes to Chapter 10 Rules

This Consultation Paper (“CP”) has been issued to provide market participants with an opportunity to comment on certain changes to Chapter 10 of the DME Rulebook.

Application of this Consultation Paper

This CP is directed primarily at current and prospective DME Members and Customers, but DME welcomes comments from any other interested parties.

Overview of Changes

The DME is proposing to make certain changes to the Chapter 10 Rules covering the treatment of delivery issues. Currently all delivery failures are to be handled by the Oman Delivery Committee (“ODC”), which is to be comprised of representatives from CME Clearing and a number of other panelists with a background in deliveries. The DME proposes to introduce an Exchange Delivery Committee (“EDC”) which can deal with delivery failures. The EDC shall be comprised of DME and CME Clearing representatives. Parties shall have the ability to appeal the decision of the EDC to the ODC.
